Business Meeting

School Reports

President Satterwhite asked if there were updates or topics new to their school they wanted to mention. Discussion as follows:

Paris High School – Rob Boyars reported that Paris now has a full time technology person. Paris has undergone administrative changes that have changed the environment positively. They will have an Accounting II class next year. Rob said that he has 30 in cooperative education. He also stated that we are working with Shilo's new business teacher, Julia North. She is observing and borrowing their curriculum.
